Question 39	Should ILCOR be excluded from the RFP, considering that ILCOR does not directly create resuscitation guidelines?
Answer 39	No, although the International Liaison Committee on Resuscitation (ILCOR) does not directly create resuscitation guidelines, it provides recommendations
	on resuscitation. These recommendations are then tested and implemented in
	Canadian resuscitation guidelines based on ILCOR recommendations.

Question 40	Considering the information outlined in Appendix 1 of Annex A- Estimated number of courses per location which specifies 20 designated training locations and varying training course quantities for each location, is the contractor required to provide
	training at all individual courses i.e. 224 courses across the 20 locations? (Estimated
	Transition Courses per Location for FA = 180 and Estimated Transition Courses per
	Location for Adv FA = 44) Alternatively, does the contractor need to train only 5
