INSERT:

“Provide a copy of the Certificate of Practice and a copy of the Architectural License.”

	<p>The examples must have been of similar size and scope to that outlined in section 1.1 Objectives and 2.3 Outline of Tasks, and the construction portion must have been completed in the last ten (10) years from bid closing.</p> <p>Each example must demonstrate that a minimum of three (3) of the following elements were achieved:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The example was for a renovation to an existing building;• The example included a multi-disciplinary design team of professional Sub-Consultants (example, engineers, interior designers, landscape architects, etc.);• The example was a security related project that included the design and construction of security infrastructure;• The example's construction value was a minimum of CAD \$1,000,000 excluding taxes; or• The example was delivered internationally (ie: outside of the country of the firms' headquarters location)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Project description (scope of work);• Project location (city, country);• Narrative describing how the project is similar in nature to the Work described in Section 2 – Outline of Tasks;• Location of the Respondent's office during the project (city, country);• Final construction cost in Canadian dollars (\$);• Start and completion date (month, year);• Description of services provided by the Respondent;• Confirmation that the Respondent was the Architectural and Engineering (A&E) Consultant on the project;• Identification of multi-disciplinary design team disciplines; and• Project photos (if applicable).
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All other conditions and requirements remain unchanged.
