#### **Amendment 001**

This amendment is raised to distribute the answers to bidder questions and make revisions to the tender package.

#### **Questions & Answers** A.

Q1 There are two pits near km 147( Blackstone River) one on the east side of the highway ( left travelling from Fort Simpson to Nahanni Butte) and one on the west side of the highway (right travelling from Fort Simpson to Nahanni Butte) can you confirm which pit we would be excavating from?

A1 Crush will be hauled from KM 80 on Highway 7. Highway 7, also known as the Liard Trail, is a gravel highway that begins at the BC border and continues north for 254 kilometres, generally following the Liard River to the junction of Highway 1.

- Q2 The contract calls for 300 m3 of material to be loaded and hauled to Nahanni Butte, but does not indicate how the measurement will be done. Is it box measure, or survey measure of the stockpile when delivered to Nahanni Butte?
- **A2** The measurement of materials will be box measure.
- Q3 The contract refers to bid security( bonding, letter of credit or bank draft) and when I check on line it indicates worth 10 % of bid, can you confirm that this applies to this contract?
- A3 As per the Invitation to Tender, bid security is required for this solicitation as per GI08 in the following link: Section 5.R.R2710T - General Instructions to Bidders - Buyandsell.gc.ca
