This amendment dated as of January 31, 2024, will amend RFP No.RFx002627 as follows:

1. Delete Section 1.5.1 Canada Buys Online Procurement Services, and replace with the following:

- **3. Delete Section 2.1.1 Proponents To Follow Instructions** and replace with the following:

### Section 2.1.1 PROPONENT INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROPOSAL SUBMISSION

# (a) Proponents to Follow Instructions

Proponents should structure their proposals in accordance with the instructions in this RFP. Where information is requested in this RFP, any response made in a proposal should reference the applicable section numbers of this RFP.

### (b) Mandatory Submission Requirements

Each proposal must be completed and include the following:

- (1) SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS FORM (APPENDIX A) (including a completed PRIVACY & SECURITY CONTROLS QUESTIONNAIRE found at Exhibit 1 of Appendix A)
- (2) PRICING FORM (APPENDIX B) (in accordance with the instructions in Appendix B)
- (3) RESPONSE TO THE STATEMENT OF WORK AND MANDATORY AND RATED CRITERIA (APPENDIX)

Proposals should include a narrative providing sufficient detail as to how the Proponents intends to address the deliverables in the Statement of Work included in Part I of Appendix C. In so doing, Proponents should ensure that the proposals clearly demonstrate the Proponents ability to meet each of the Mandatory Criteria. To assist with the evaluation of its proposals, Proponents shall include as part of the proposals a completed Mandatory Criteria Table as found at Table 7 of Part II of Appendix C of the RFP. Proponents should also clearly identify in their proposals how they meet each of the rated Criteria by clearly identifying the elements that are relevant to the evaluation of each of the Rated Criteria.

**4. Delete Table 8 – Rated Criteria** and replace with the Table below which includes amendments to R1 and R3.

Any inaccurate, misleading, or incomplete information, including withdrawn or altered pricing, could adversely affect the evaluation or ranking or the decision of CMHC to enter into an agreement with the Proponent for the Deliverables.

### 3.0 How to determine pricing

The Proponent is expected to present a pricing model for a 7-year period based on the provision of the Services and Deliverables set out Sections 5 and 6 of Part I of Schedule C – Statement of Work. The Total of the Pricing Table is calculated by adding the Annual Fees for each of Year 1 to 7.

Start-up costs shall be reflected in the Annual Fee for the year in which they will be incurred.

# 4.0 Pricing Table

For the provision of the Services and Deliverables described in the APPENDIX C – Statement of Work, Proponents will set out their fees (**defined as Operational funding**) as shown in the Table 5 below. This includes activities as listed in the Operational funding definition under Statement of Work 1.0 Definitions.
