In other words, is it possible and compliant to submit a wetland or bank restoration project without it being affected by beaver habitat?

A1. It is neither possible nor compliant to submit a wetland or bank restoration project without it being affected by beaver habitat.

Beaver habitat must absolutely be present in the experiment AND, what's more, we're looking for contractors with experience in maintaining beaver habitat and infrastructure (not destroying it).
