## Amendment 003

This amendment is raised to answer questions from bidders

## A. Questions and Answers

Clarification question/answer 1 from Amendment 002

Q1. Could you please clarify.

According to your answer to question 1 of amendment no.2 published on March 1, 2024, we could understand that the 2 projects in examples must involve the beaver. However, the mandatory requirements refer to "at least one".

A1. The following requirement '*It is neither possible nor compliant to submit a wetland or bank restoration project without it being affected by beaver habitat. Beaver habitat must absolutely be present in the experiment AND, what's more, we're looking for contractors with experience in maintaining beaver habitat and infrastructure (not destroying it).*" applies to only one of the two required projects.

At least one project in restoration of wetlands or riverbanks, or aquatic AND forest environments with work that preserved the beaver's habitat and maintained its infrastructure (not destroyed it).

ALL OTHER TERMS & CONDITIONS REMAIN UNCHANGED.
