

**ANNEX C**

**Mandatory Technical Evaluation Criteria**

**Evaluation Methodology** – The evaluation will be conducted by Representatives of Canada and will consider only the criteria provided. Mandatory requirements are identified by the word “must.” All mandatory criteria must be met or the offer submission will be deemed non-compliant. Failure to provide sufficient detail in the offer submission to evaluate the proposal against the mandatory criteria will also deem the offer non-compliant.

To avoid duplication and delays, Offerors should refer to different sections of their offers by identifying the specific paragraph and page number where the subject topic has already been addressed.

M2	<b>Minimum Qualification: Capability:</b> The Bidder must provide attestation of their capability to meet the time constraints for Routine and Urgent Pick-ups as identified at the <b>Annex A, Para 2.2.3 - Time Constraints – Task Authorizations. Bidders must complete the Attestation Certification at Part 5.3.1 of the Solicitation</b>				
M3	<b>Minimum Qualification: Experience:</b> The Bidder must have two (2) years of experience within the last five (5) providing transport and Disposal of Hazardous Waste materials within Canada. Bidders must demonstrate their experience by providing a list of three (3) relevant contracts valued at <b>\$10,000.00</b> or over including contract identification number, name of the client, and contact information for the client including valid e-mail, telephone number and the name of Person of Contact.
