- A10. Completed and signed cover page of the Request for Supply Arrangement (RFSA), and any associated amendment.

Once the evaluation of the above information is completed, we will request additional information to ensure that security requirements are met as outlined in Sections 1.2.1 Security, 1.3 Security Requirements, and 6.2 Security Requirements.

- **Q11.** Should we be submitting signed cover pages from amendments that have been issued after a Supply Arrangement submission, to acknowledge receipt of the amendments?
- **A11.** Not necessarily. If additional information is required after a submission and during the evaluation, we would reach out to Suppliers requesting the additional information.
- **Q12.** What is the anticipated turn-around for review of our submission, requests for any additional documentation/information, and the implementation of a Supply Arrangement?
- **A12.** There are many components to completing an evaluation and awarding a Supply Arrangement. There are no set timelines or due dates.
- Q13. The submission of CVs is required for Principal Investigators and Lab Supervisors. Do you require a full CV or would you prefer a two (2) page CV.
- A13. We are asking for the most recent and applicable CVs. Additional pages beyond two (2) is acceptable, as long as it demonstrates applicable, recent and transferable work experience. CVs need to support experience and relate to Appendix 1 and 2.
- **Q14.** If a person has experience in multiple regions do you want to see their resumes in each region separately of just once?
- **A14.** We would accept either one (1) CV covering multiple regions, or separate CVs for each region.
- **Q15.** For Appendix 2 (individual work experience), do we submit one (1) Excel sheet with tabs for each individuals, or multiple Excel sheets?
- **A15.** Yes, one (1) excel sheet with tabs at the bottom is sufficient.
- **Q16.** In Section 4. Supplier Experience of Annex B Technical Evaluation & Submission Requirements, must we submit four (4) full reports, or just project summaries?
- **A16.** Full reports are required for the three (3) archaeological reports. A maximum of three (3) pages must be submitted for the historical research in primary documents example.
- Q17. In Section 4. Supplier Experience of Annex B Technical Evaluation & Submission Requirements, must we submit four (4) reports and three (3) references by region separately, or by Supplier?
- **A17.** No. That is not our expectation. We would require (1) historical research and (3) archaeological reports per submission, but not necessarily for each region.

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Q18. Can non-archaeological personnel be added (for example Georgraphic Information System (GIS) support)? Especially if the need is demonstrated on a particular project during a solicitation process?

A18. Yes, they can be included. For the RFSA, we are assessing and qualifying Principal Investigators and Lab Supervisors only. If a particular project needs other areas of support or specialties, it will be indicated for that specific project.
