AMENDMENT 001

Amendment 001 is raised to answer the questions below and revise **ATTACHMENT 1 to ANNEX A – UNIT PRICE FORM**.

QUESTION 1:

Regarding the travel costs. If the successful applicant is traveling to remote areas via flight or ferry, is there a minimum call out number of hours per piece of work?

ANSWER 1

There is no minimum call out number of hours.

QUESTION 2:

How can we build the travel rates into the contract if the individual projects could be 16 hours or 40 hours? INSTRUCTIONS TO OFFERORS:

- 1. Complete this Price Proposal Form and submit in accordance with GI06 Submission of Offers.
- 2. OFFERORS SHALL NOT ALTER THIS FORM.
- 3. Price Proposals are not to include Applicable Taxes.
- 4. Price Proposals will be evaluated in Canadian Dollars.
- 5. Authorized travel expenses for work As and When Required:
 - a) Travel may be required and will be reimbursed in accordance with the National Joint Council Travel Directive for Contractors; travel requirements will be indicated on the individual call-up at the time of award. All travel will be calculated from the work location and not from the Offeror's site or home.
 - b) The Contractor will be reimbursed its authorized travel expenses reasonably and properly incurred in the performance of the Work done, delivered or performed outside of a 100 km travel radius, by private vehicle; (100 km is understood to be a one-way trip, not 100 km return), at cost, without any allowance for profit and/or administrative overhead, in accordance with the meal and private vehicle allowances specified in Appendices B, C and D of the National Joint Council Travel Directive (https://www.njc-cnm.gc.ca/directive/d10/en), and with the other provisions of the directive referring to "travellers", rather than those referring to "employees". Canada will not pay the Contractor any incidental expense allowance for authorized travel.
 - c) Canada will not accept travel expenses that may need to be incurred by the Contractor for any relocation of resources required to satisfy its contractual obligations.
 - d) All travel must have the prior authorization of the Project Authority and must be included in the Contractor's offer as indicated in SOP04 CALL-UP PROCEDURE.
 - e) For Work to be performed outside the 100 km radius: The Contractor will be paid its authorized travel time, reasonably and properly incurred in the performance of the Work, at a rate of 50% of the General Labourer Rate, without any allowance for overhead or profit.
 - f) The authorized travel expenses will be paid upon submission of an itemized statement supported by receipt youchers. All payments are subject to government audit.
- 6. The prices per unit will govern in establishing the *Total Evaluated Price*. Any arithmetical errors in this Attachment will be corrected by Canada.
- 7. *Estimated Quantity (Hours) in column (b), in all pricing tables, is for evaluation purposes only.
- 8. The pricing tables in the resulting Standing Offer will not include: columns (b); the Extended Price columns; or the subtotal rows.
