## Addenda\#1-Questions and Answers

1. Q: Are there specific requirements/limitations regarding access to certain areas for the installation and removal of lights? e.g., Installation and Removal of lights in trees along Anderson Street can only be performed during the hours of 20:00-06:00.

A: The install and removal of lights must be scheduled to avoid impeding access to tenants’ spaces during business hours and to not block vehicle and pedestrian traffic during operating hours. All work is to be preplanned and reviewed with the contract manager in advance of installations and removals.
2. Q: Is it just one selfie station at the Wharf? Or are they wanting multiple selfie stations?

A: We require one on the wharf (Public Market Courtyard deck) and one in Ron Basford Park (on the point overlooking False Creek). These areas have no size limitations. We would like you to recommend designs and locations for two other "selfie stations".
3. Q: Do they want lights on the Wharf or just being able to reflect off the water?

A: We want the installation to be a draw for visitors and pleasing to the folks across on the other side of False Creek. We want it to reflect in the water, but it can't cast light on the residences.
4. Q: In the allies are they wall light or lit hanging decor?

A: That is for you to recommend, keeping in mind possible limitations that may require drilling into building facades.
5. Q: On the tower of the Net Loft building, can we hang decor?

A: Yes, keeping in mind possible limitations that may require drilling into building facades.
6. $\mathbf{Q}:$ Lights around and about in front of the bakery?

A: Yes, the bakery (A Bread Affair) is one of the buildings that needs to be decorated. In front of this building, an outdoor location called Triangle Square is another place where you might want to consider a "selfie" station.
