### Description:

The Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) requires a National Individual Standing Offer (NISO) for the provision of Laser aiming devises with accessories that will attach to the operator weapon platform to project a laser showing the user where his weapon is pointed.

The period of the Standing Offer is from the date of issuance of the Standing Offer to three (3) years later, plus four (4) additional extension periods of one (1) year.
