A. Solicitation Closing Date

The closing date for solicitation 5P468-23-0004/A, titled "Naval architect and construction quality advisor – Mingan Archipelago National Park Reserve.", is extended from May 16, 2024, until May 23, 2024.

B. Questions and Answers

- **Q1:** "Bilingual professional services" can you clarify, should all my staffs to be bilingual or only for the communication purpose?
- A1: Not all staff need to be bilingual. The requirement is for written and verbal communications as well as the review and comment of the documentation submitted. This requires that a technical person (the naval architect or senior technician assigned to the contract) be able to communicate in French with the client and with the shipyard in the language (French or English) being used in the shipyard that remains to be selected. Communications with the shipyard will also include documentation for which Parks Canada will request a review for comments in the language used by the shipyard. Please note that no translation costs required by the naval architecture firm for the review and comment of the documentation submitted, nor for written or verbal communications, will be billable. For information, the official translation of the documentation will be the responsibility of the shipyard once the working documents have been reviewed and approved.
- **Q2**. Can you provide the technical specification for the acquisition of the barge (approximately 75 pages) of landing Craft #1 referred to page 18/29 in the RFP Doc of 29 pages.
- A2. No since the technical specification is linked to an independent tender yet to be published. A 12-hour allowance under Service Required (RS) 01 was allocated accordingly.
