SOLICITATION AMENDMENT # 001

This solicitation amendment is raised to:

1. Address the following questions submitted during the solicitation period as per RFP.

1. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q1. Can the delivery mechanism be expanded to include internet delivery and the use of Virtual Humans as language tutors? We use Virtual Humans to speak with people who access our application via the internet.

Can the scope be broadened to include innovative technology solutions that deliver language training according to today educational best practices.

- Experiential, immersive, task-based, student-led..... etc.
- **A1**. No, the CRA will not accept any other methodologies except the Virtual Language Training as described in the Annex A Statement of Work.
- **Q2.** The use of "telephones" for training purposes seems a restrictive and determental approach to language training. "As we ourselves are a minority business, we would like to submit to this tender but the terminology of the procurement (telephone) prevents us from applying." We do not use "telephones" for our training.
- **A2.** The Contractors must provide telephone tutoring on an "as and when requested basis" as described in the Annex A Statement of Work. The CRA will not consider any modifications in the SOW.
