

Question 1

Can the Crown specify what the technical/financial criteria ratio is for the basis of selection?

Answer 1

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The basis of selection is a minimum point rating as indicated in section 4.6.1 under 4.6 Basis of Selection. There is no technical/financial ratio.

Question 2

R2 of the RFSO states that we are to demonstrate our experience in delivering in-person or virtual trainings sessions or workshop that are a minimum of 2 days in duration per session in the last three years. The Bidders Guide states that we must demonstrate at least four workshops or training sessions that have run a minimum of three consecutive days. Please could you clarify whether the requirement is for two or three days?

Answer 2

It's two consecutive days. The Bidders Guide (202204867-B) states that we must demonstrate at least four workshops or training sessions that have run a minimum of two consecutive days

Question 3

Please could you clarify the following regarding Sub-Contracting:

We understand that this standing offer is a set-aside for Indigenous businesses and that at least 33% of the value of any contract arising from the Standing Offer must be completed either by the prime contractor or subcontracted to an Indigenous sub-contractor. Please could you confirm or clarify that a contract under this Standing Offer:

May be offered to a non-Indigenous contractor for up to 66% of the value of a contract, with the remaining 33% being given to an Indigenous subcontractor or completed by the prime contractor that is an Indigenous business;

A non-Indigenous sub-contractor may take on the whole contract, but must ensure that at least 33% of the contract value is completed by Indigenous people

Answer 3

Standing Offers can only be given to indigenous business that are registered with Industry Canada's Aboriginal business database. In turn, the indigenous business must be able to demonstrate that 33% of the value of the work to be performed over the course of the Standing Offer will be completed by the Indigenous business. The 33% requirement does not apply to employees or sub-contractors of an Indigenous firm registered on the Indigenous Business Directory.
