B. Questions and Answers

- Q1.** In the evaluation criteria for project experience, when you say the bidder, do you mean the actual contract holder, the Indigenous contract holder or can it also include our partners and our discipline participants?
- A1.** At least two projects examples provided must be completed by the bidder as the prime contractor (as per Mandatory Requirements). If the bidding entity is a joint venture ie. between two firms, projects under either partner firm would count as experience under the prime contractor.
- Q2.** Can you explain mandatory Indigenous labour? What would be the minimum requirement for that?
- A2.** The evaluation criteria does not include mandatory Indigenous labour requirements. However, since this is a Procurement Strategy for Indigenous Businesses (PSIB), the awarded contractor must register on the Indigenous Business Directory (IBD). As per the Indigenous Services Canada website, to be eligible for the IBD; "In instances where 1 or more Indigenous businesses, as defined under the rules of PSIB, are involved in a contract with 1 or more non-Indigenous businesses or individual contractors, 33% of the total monetary value of the work contracted for must be performed by Indigenous businesses." - Q3.** Do we need to be registered in IBD during Stage 1 and 2 solicitation period?
- A3:** The bidding entity must be eligible to be registered in the Indigenous Business Directory (IBD) to submit a bid. However, the bidding entity must be registered in IBD prior to contract award. Bidders are encouraged to start their registration process to avoid delays.
