

NOTICE OF PROPOSED PROCUREMENT

Description of the Requirement:

The Department of National Defence/Canadian Armed Forces and the Department of Justice have established a working group to identify the most effective framework for the creation of a permanent military court of Canada. The services of one (1) independent authority is required to ensure adequate expertise and an appropriate external perspective is provided to the working group.

The initial contract period will be from date of contract award to one (1) year later. There are two (2) six-month option periods associated with this requirement.

Canada Free Trade Agreement (CFTA)

Comprehensive Land Claims Agreement:

There will be no set-aside for aboriginal businesses. This procurement is not subject to a Comprehensive Land Claims Agreement.

Requirement Details:

Tasks and Deliverables are detailed in Annex "A" of the Request for Proposal (RFP).

The Mandatory and Point Rated Criteria are detailed in the RFP.

The basis of selection shall be the compliant Bidder that offers the Highest Combined Rating of Technical Merit [60%] and Price [40%].

For services requirements, Bidders must provide the required information as detailed in article 2.3 of Part 2 of the bid solicitation, in order to comply with Treasury Board policies and directives on contracts awarded to former public servants.

The Crown retains the rights to negotiate with suppliers on any procurement.

Documents may be submitted in either official language of Canada.

There is currently no contract in place for this service.

DND reserves the right not to award a contract, regardless of the proposals received.

Where this notice and the RFP differ, the RFP shall prevail.
