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## **Amendment 001**

This amendment is raised to provide responses to bidder questions.

A. Answer questions from bidders;

### **A. Questions and Answers**

**Q1. Are employees responsible for cleaning dishes or maintaining cleanliness in the kitchen areas?**

**A1.** Employees are asked to attend to their mishaps/dishes throughout the day. However, if stains or dirt persist from kitchen use until scheduled contracted cleaning activities start it is up to the contractor to clean the kitchen areas according to the tasks stated in the Statement of Work which does not include washing dishes.

**Q2. Would damages to the buildings/to be cleaned items need to be reported to the project authority?**

**A2.** Yes, they would need to be reported in writing as stated in paragraph 3.3.3 of the Statement of Work. Paragraph 3.3.3 was read to attendees and confirmed whether this answers the question sufficiently.

**Q3. Are areas surrounding the sea-can operated by Jasper Tourism included in the litter pick up activities surrounding the Jasper National Park Heritage Firehall?**

**A3.** No, the sea-can area as well as the public alleyway behind the firehall would not be included in litter pick up. Only areas directly adjacent to the Fire hall (front, sides, back) would be required to be cleaned. Areas were pointed out on site.

**Q4. What happens if the Floor Scrubber in the Maintenance Compound is broken.**

**A4.** The floors need to be serviced to the same standard as stated in 3.7.5. The particular method is up to the contractor as long as the same standard is achieved, and no additional cost is incurred by Parks Canada.

**Q5. Are locked offices to be cleaned?**

**A5.** No, unless instructed otherwise by the Project Authority.

**Q6. Would the Maintenance Compound be accessed through the main front door across from Dispatch.**

**A6.** Yes, it would be accessed there.
